**ORDINANCE
BANNING STREETSIDE PARKING DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER
IN THE BOROUGH OF LAFLIN**

WHEREAS, Council for the Borough of Lafin recognizes the inherent danger during snow, ice and under such inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, Council equally recognizes the need to provide not only for the safety of residents of the Borough, but also for the safety of all persons travelling the roadways of the Borough; and





THAT, street-side parking shall not be permitted alongside any street in the Borough of Lafin whenever said roadway has any accumulation of wintry precipitation, including, but not limited to snow, sleet or ice; and

THAT, residents are hereby on notice that such weather requires plowing of roads and spreading of salt which places property at risk of damage; and

THAT, anyone street-side parking in and around the time of inclement weather does so at his or her own risk and the Borough will not be responsible for damage that occurs during the necessary process of street clearing and salting; and

THAT, violators of this ordinance shall pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) together with costs and fees imposed by the Court; and

THAT, any prior Ordinances or Resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed; and

THAT, if any term or terms herein are held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid said term or terms are severable and the remaining terms shall remain in effect; and

THAT, this Ordinance shall be effective immediately.
